

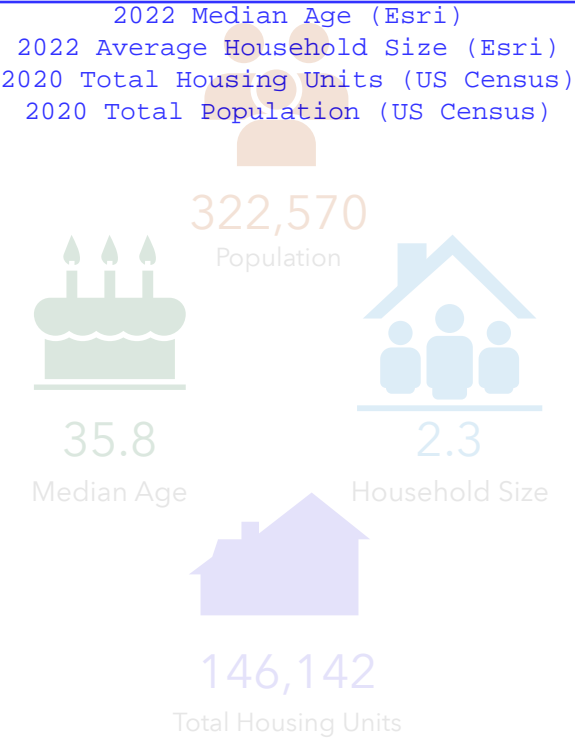

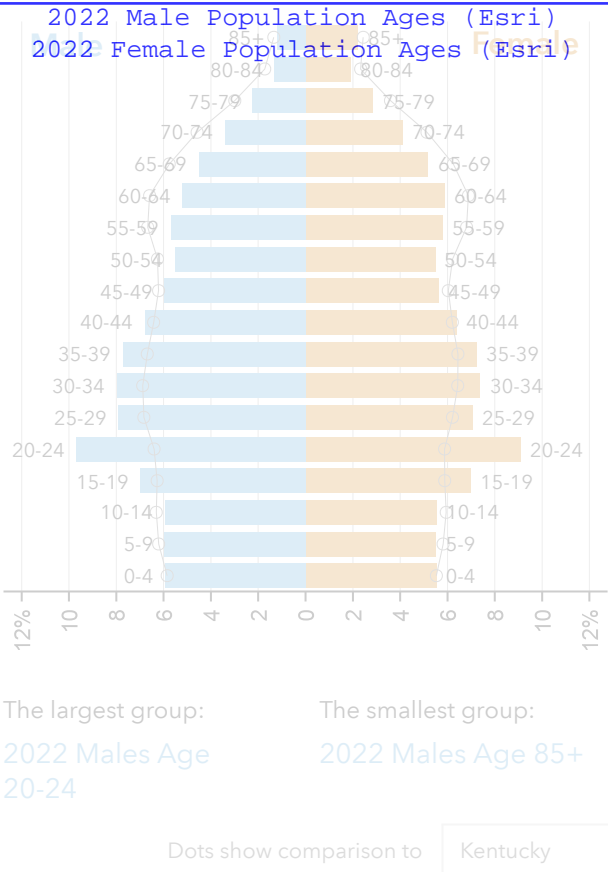

## POPULATION PYRAMID



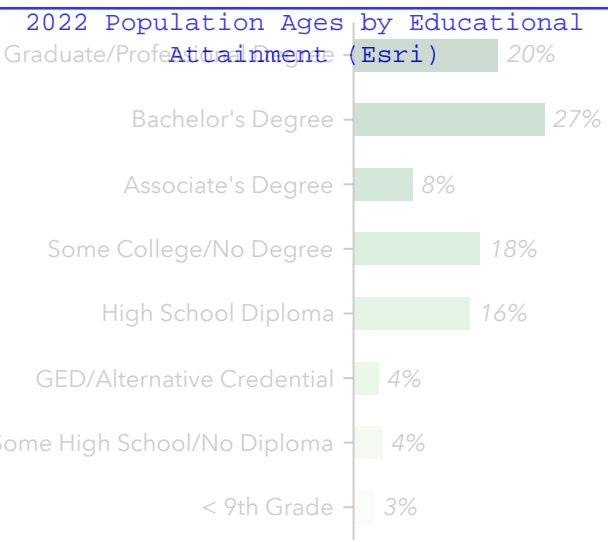

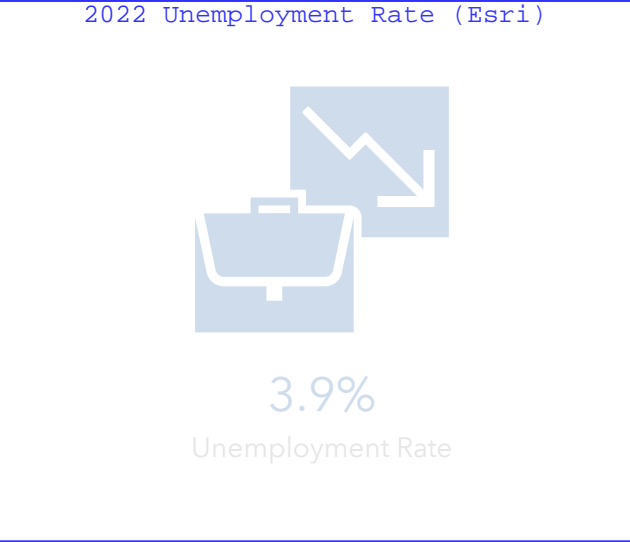

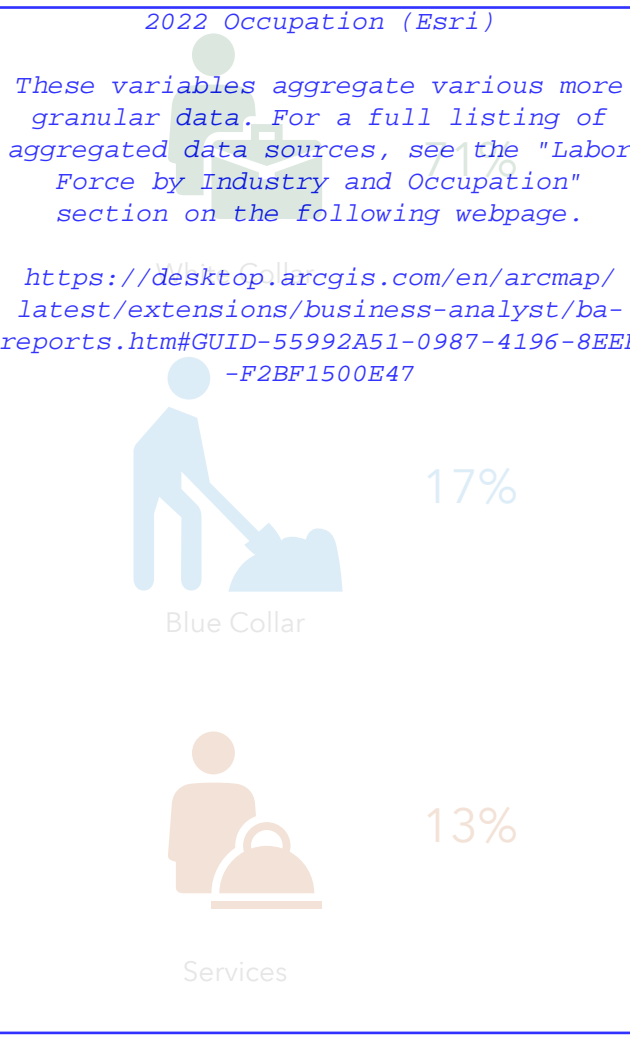

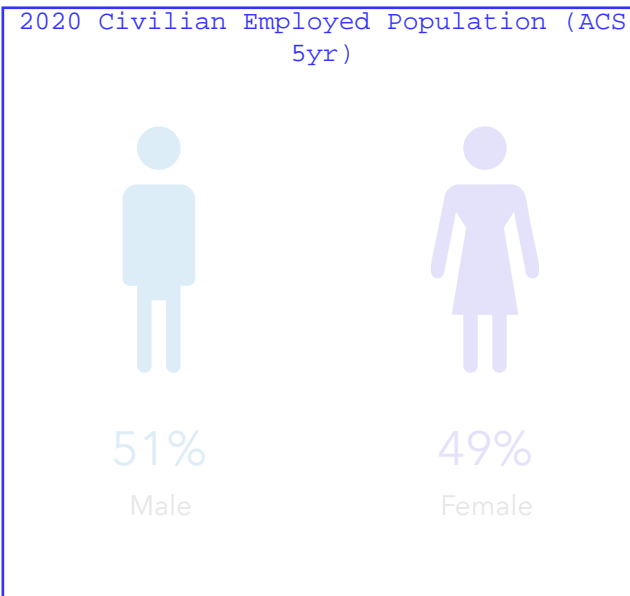

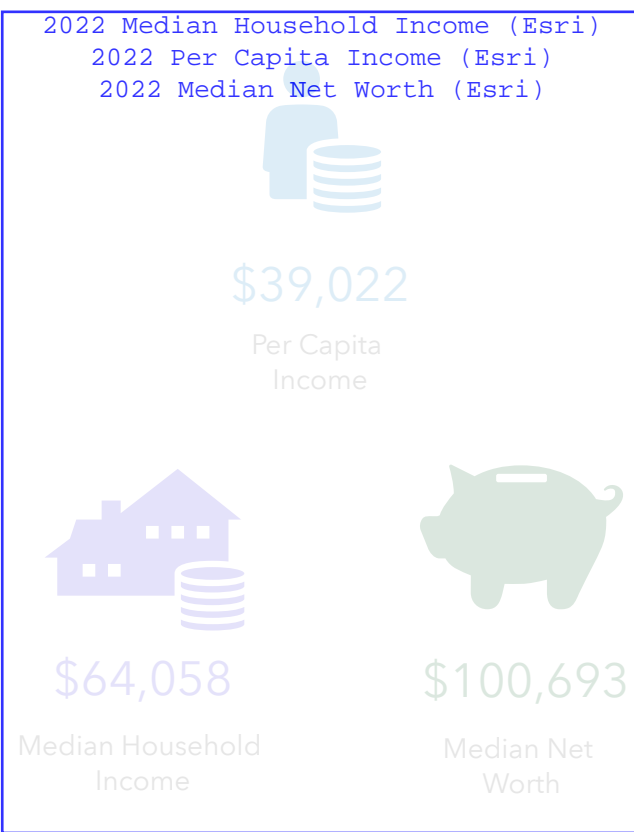


## WORKFORCE BY GENDER

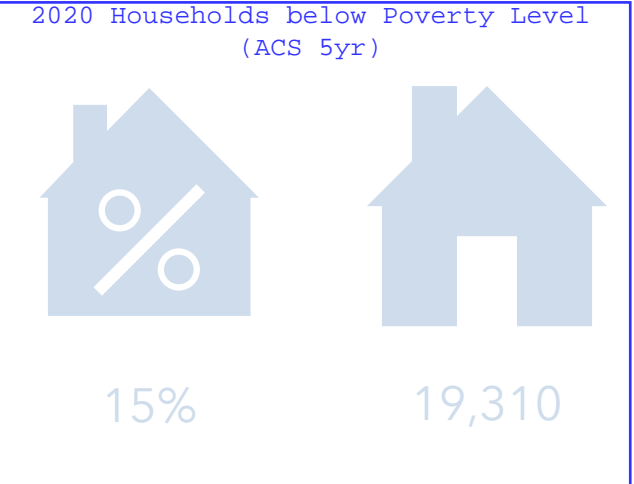

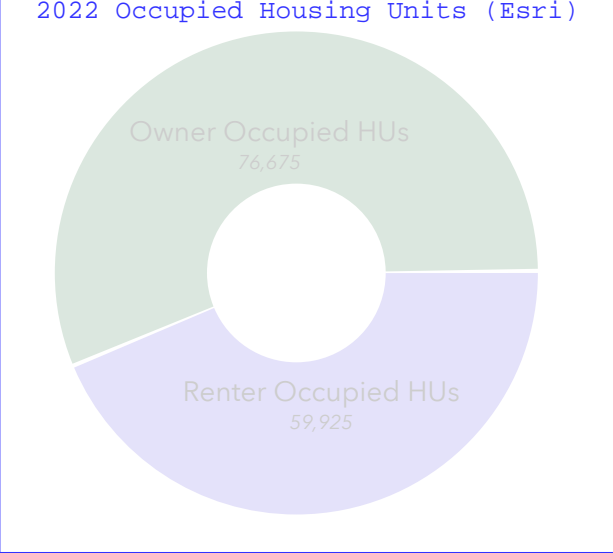

## HOUSEHOLDS BELOW POVERTY LEVEL

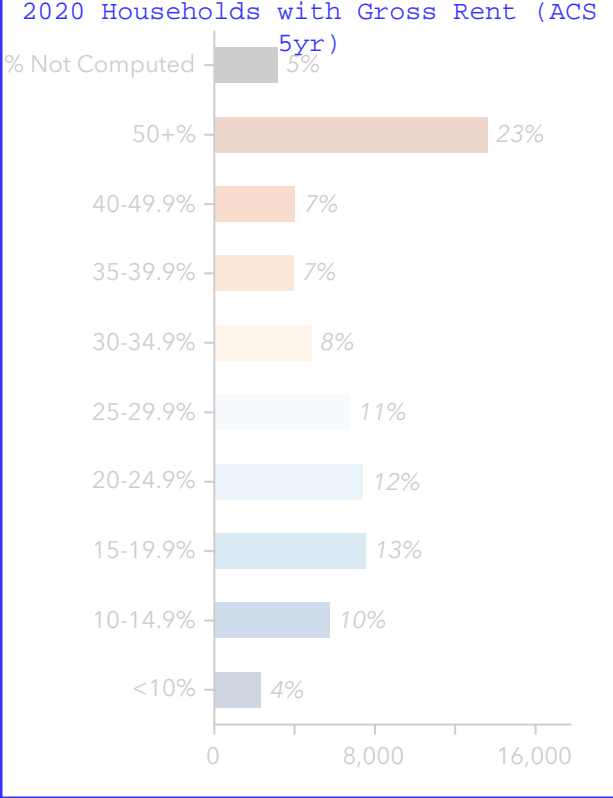

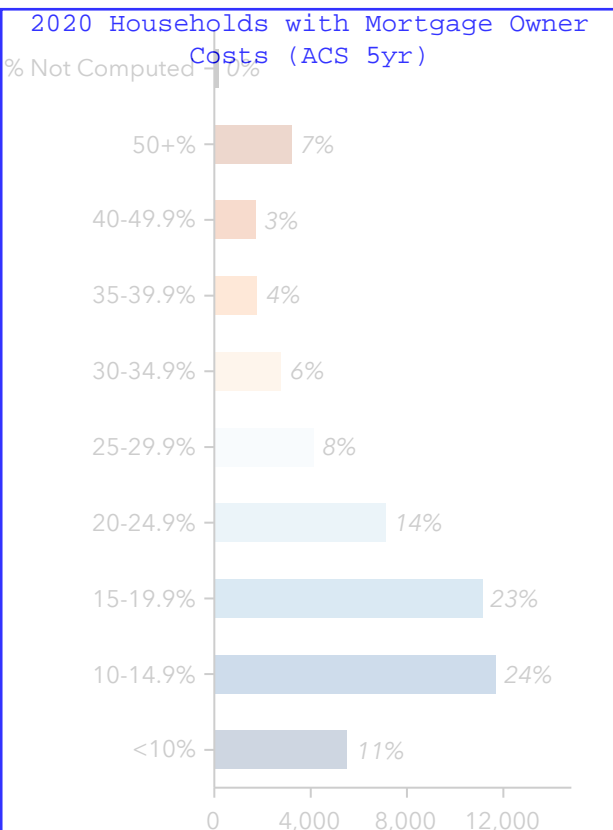
## OCCUPIED HOUSING UNITS



## GROSS RENT AS % OF INCOME

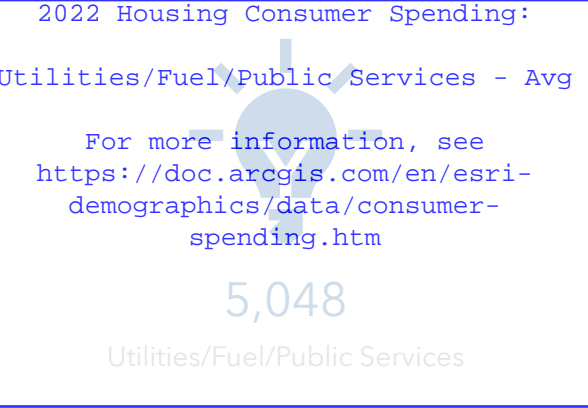


## OWNER COSTS AS % OF INCOME

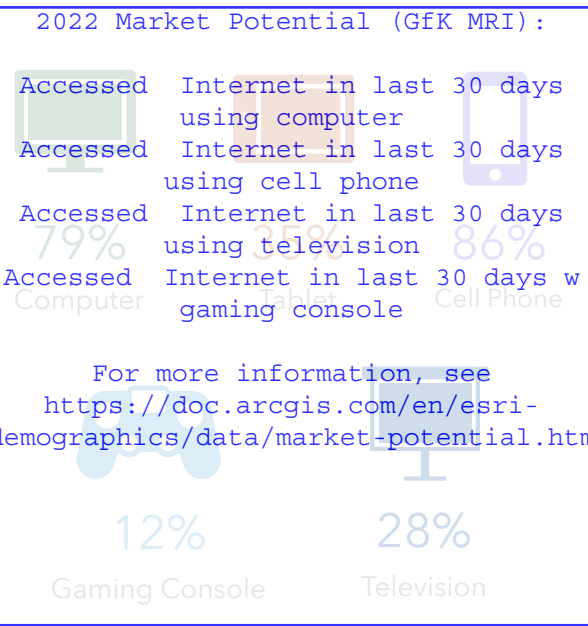

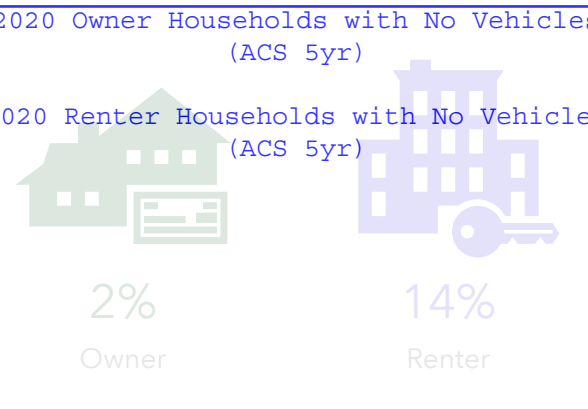
## ANNUAL HOUSEHOLD UTILITY COSTS
